- Almanacs are updated every year.

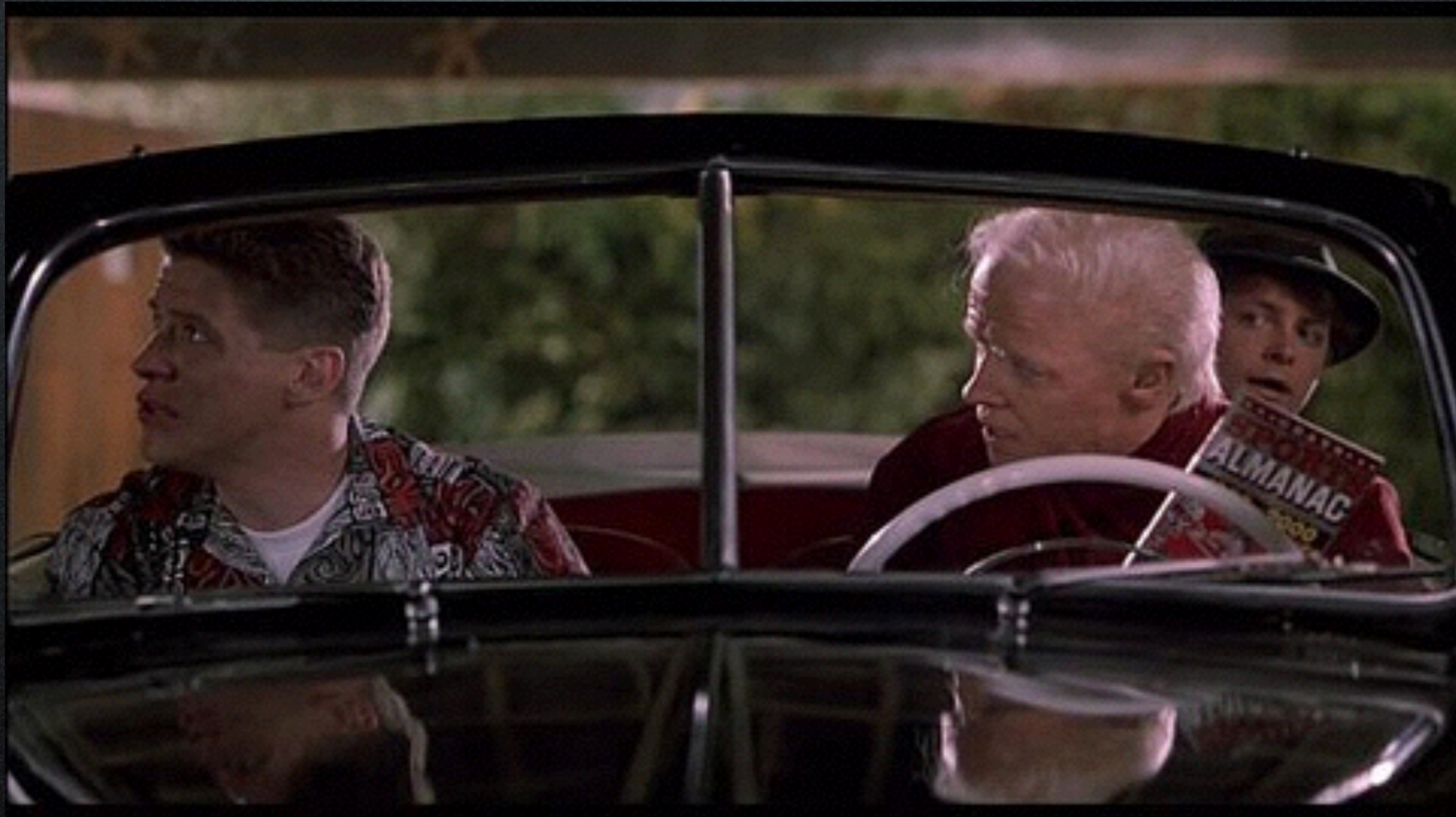



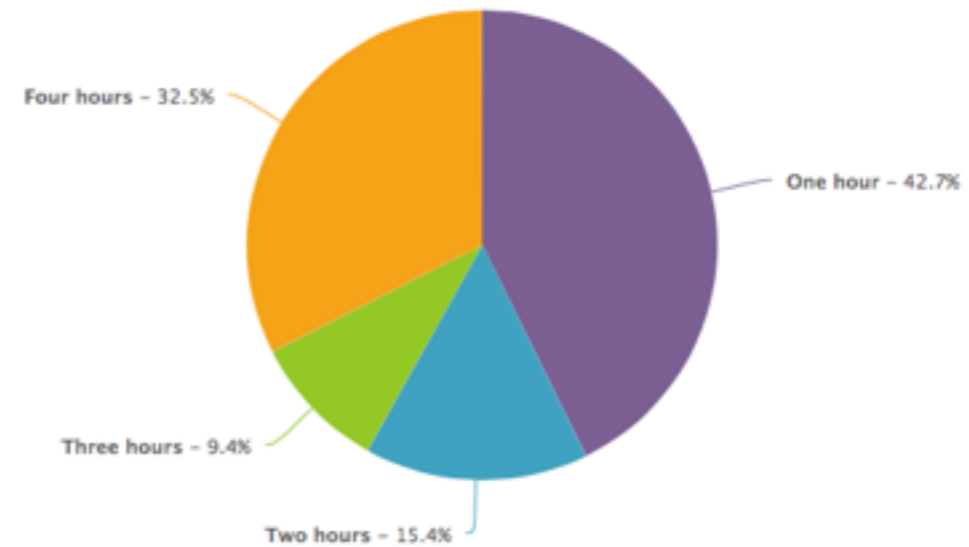
